



KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- The Clinical Program Manager will help implement and support clinical information technologies inclusive of an Electronic Medical Record across acute care facilities by leveraging information systems investments, sharing best practices, ensuring effective system utilization, and identifying areas for process improvement and standardization.
- He/she will interact with various healthcare professionals, facility leadership, and vendor resources in planning and creating integrated project plans that encompass all technical, business, and communication aspects of a project and will manage all phases of a project lifecycle including leading project teams, handling issue escalation, and managing project budgets.

- He/she will assume role in establishing and maintaining effective governance structures for large multifacility organizations.
